# FOREWORD TO THE REPORT

We present the 2024 Annual Report of the Manly-Warringah Rugby League Football Club (MWRLFC).

We are proud to produce the Report as has been done every year since 1946, including the statistics for all grades. We believe we owe it to every player who pulls on the Manly-Warringah Sea Eagles jersey to have their name and other details recorded in this document, whether they played one game or 300 games.

By producing this report, we do not purport to represent ourselves as the Manly Warringah Sea Eagles Limited (MWSE Ltd) which is a separate legal entity administering and funding the Team.

The MWRLFC of which you are a member is a minority owner of the MWSE Ltd. That means that MWRLFC members also have an ownership stake in the MWSE Ltd, the Sea Eagles.

The MWRLFC holds the Preference Share in the Manly-Warringah Sea Eagles Ltd which gives our members, through their right to vote, determination over the Team's name, colours, and its home ground, as well as two voting positions on the MWSE Ltd Board which, like the Football Club has seven members.

It is pleasing that our membership numbers remain strong. It is important that we maintain our relevance as an organisation. Strong membership numbers ensure the voice of our members (Sea Eagles fans) cannot be ignored. Our voice and our place within the Sea Eagles family is always important in the event there is a change to the ownership or governance of the Sea Eagles.

As always, we encourage MWRLFC members wherever possible and affordable, to also be members of the Sea Eagles.

This report has largely been compiled from publicly available data and our own records with all photography credits to the Sea Eagles. We thank all the contributors for their reports. The production of the Report is done on a voluntary basis and the cost of printing the Report is wholly funded by the MWRLFC through the membership income.

This year's cover features Haumole Olakau'atu who was a stand out performer during the Season and was rewarded for his efforts by being selected in the NSW Origin Team and for Tonga.

Above all, thank you, our wonderful members for your ongoing support and membership of the Football Club.

# CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

It's an honour to present the 2024 Report of the Manly-Warringah Rugby League Football Club (MWRLFC). It's a privilege for me to continue to lead this historic Club.

The 2024 season began with the Sea Eagles making history as the first NRL Club to win a regular season game in Las Vegas when we defeated the Rabbitohs 36-24 at Allegiant Stadium. Like the many Sea Eagles fans who travelled to watch the game, it was an incredible experience. Manly fans can only dream of playing out of such a stadium. The Sea Eagles team from players to coaching staff and the administration led by CEO Tony Mestrov were a credit to the entire Club. The logistics of playing the match in Las Vegas were extraordinary, and there were many risks, but it's a matter of pride to report how it was all conducted without a hitch and returning with the two points.



The team returned home and then defeated the Roosters two weeks later at a sold-out 4 Pines Park/Brookvale Oval – a great start to the season!

Sold out home games were a great feature of the 2024 season for the Club, with only two not achieving the house full sign. This is a fantastic result for the team who get to enjoy the full-throated support of the Manly supporters and, importantly, financially for the Club. As a reward to the fans for their support, in 2025 all 12 home games will be played at 4 Pines Park/Brookvale Oval. This is a win-win for the team and the fans and from a Sea Eagles Board Member perspective a no-brainer of a decision.

In 2024 Anthony Seibold and his men once more achieved improvement from the previous year with 13 wins and a draw compared with 11 wins and a draw from the 2023 season. We made it through to the second week of the finals and had home ground wins against three of the top four teams, Storm, Panthers and the Roosters.

As well as those memorable home wins against the top teams, we also defeated Parramatta, St George, Knights, Titans and the Warriors at home but let the one against the Raiders slip away. We got revenge for that later with an emphatic away win at GIO Stadium. Other notable away wins included the Titans and the Bulldogs. But the game that to some degree probably saved our season was the golden point win against Cowboys in Townsville. Daly Cherry-Evans - "the best golden point closer in the game" – slotted a field goal in the 83rd minute to win the game. The opportunity came off the back of a Jake Trbojevic charge down earlier which earned Jake the "Menzies Medal" for the Play of the Year at the Sea Eagles Awards night.

The Elimination Final win against the Bulldogs was one to savour. The fact we were able to fight our way back to a win was a great sign of an improving team. Tolu Koula's individual effort to score to win the game was an absolute highlight. Without making excuses, the opening minute of play in the Semi-Final against the Roosters at their home ground pretty much sealed the fate of that game to stop our further progression. With Tolu Koula knocked out of the game, then Jake sent to the head bin for the next 15 minutes, it was always going to be difficult to get back on the front foot.

Congratulations to Anthony Seibold and every member of the squad for a great season.

Another record-breaking season was achieved by the Captain, Daly Cherry-Evans. When he surpassed the 309 first grade games mark – he broke my own record and officially became the Sea Eagles' most capped player. At end of season 2024 DCE sits at 329 first grade games. I should point out that the great Steve "Beaver" Menzies played 349 games for the Club if you include the Northern Eagles, but sadly for Steve the NRL refuses to acknowledge the only Club he even signed with was the Manly Sea Eagles ... just saying. But congratulations to DCE!

While I mention DCE - congratulations also to him and Jake Trbojevic for being named captains for their respective state teams - QLD and NSW in the 2024 State of Origin series. What an honour for them and our Club to have produced both captains!

Our own godfather, Life Member and Co-Patron, Ken "Arko" Arthurson was finally inducted into the NRL Hall of Fame – probably something that should have happened a long time ago. Ken turned 95 this year, so it was fantastic that he was able to travel to Sydney to accept the honour in person. Former Manly Player #274 Les Boyd, was also inducted into the hall of fame – congratulations Les.

In 2024 the MWRLFC board decided to sponsor the inaugural Manly Leagues Sydney Shield Team. The Sydney Shield is

the New South Wales Rugby League's (NSWRL) fourth tier competition and feeds into the Ron Massey Cup. Importantly, it provides a platform for both young emerging stars and seasoned veterans. The decision to enter a team in the competition and the MWRLFC board's decision to provide financial support was based on the opportunity it provided to allow mainly local players to participate in a high standard competition under the broad umbrella of the Manly-Warringah Rugby League banner. In 2024 the team was coached by MWRLFC Life Member and former premierships winning player Anthony "Choc" Watmough and featured a range of players including players who had played SG Ball, Jersey Flegg and local A-Grade players. It became known as "The Community Team".

The Manly Leagues Sydney Shield side won 8 of their 18 games in their first year which was an absolute credit to the Club and the Coach. They were always competitive and enjoyable to watch including on the memorable occasions they were able to play at 4 Pines Park/Brookvale Oval. Congratulations to Choc, David O'Donnell, Hanna Clare, the junior league, the entire volunteer coaching staff and of course the players for a great first year. Also big thanks to the naming rights sponsor Manly Leagues, major sponsor BiM and all the other local businesses that put their hands in their pockets to support the new venture.

A huge congratulations to Jake Watmough. Wearing the same number 11 as his famous dad, Jake was the heart and soul of the Sydney Shield side all season. This achievement was confirmed at the NSWRL awards night when he was named as the NSWRL Sydney Shield Player of the Year. Well done Jake.

The Club continued its long-time participation in the male junior representative competitions – Harold Matthews, SG Ball and Jersey Flegg. The Jersey Flegg team was set to participate in the finals (final five) however two narrow losses in their final two matches having lost some players to the NSW Cup team, meant they missed out on qualification. The MWRLFC is also thrilled that the NSW Cup side will once more play under the Sea Eagles banner in 2025.

2024 was another first for the women's game on the Northern Beaches with the entry of a Sea Eagles team in the Harvey Norman NSW Women's Premiership competition. This competition is an open-age elite competition for women players in NSW and for our Club an important stepping stone towards having a team in the NRLW competition. The Harvey Norman team was an addition to the Sea Eagles' participation in the Tarsha Gale (under 19s) and Lisa Fiaola (Under 17s) competitions. Although the HN team's first season ended with 3 wins and 1 draw from 11 games, the team was always competitive and played tough. Sadly it has been determined that the team will be "paused" until a Sea Eagles NRLW team is confirmed, which is something of a set back for the women's game but we will still have the Tarsha Gale and Lisa Fiaola teams to support in 2025, giving young women on the northern beaches the opportunity to play in a Manly Jersey.

It's always sad at the end of the season to farewell players, including Ben Condon, Matt Lodge, Jamie Humphreys, Karl Lawton, Jaxson Paulo and Aaron Woods. Earlier in the year we farewelled Christian Tuipulotu and of course most notably Josh Schuster who was a prodigious talent. We wish all departing and retiring players all the very best.

Special mention to the retirement of Brad Parker. Brad is a local junior from Manly Christian Brothers and a one club player who gave great service. Something of a fan favourite, Brad played 117 first grade games with the club over an eight-year stint. He made his debut in 2016 against the Warriors in Perth. His first assignment was to mark the much bigger, older and more experienced Manu "the Beast" Vatuvei on the wing and did himself proud not only by playing well and being part of the 15-14 golden point win (another DCE field goal) but actually stopping a Vatuvei try. This became the hallmark of "Parks" – tough, dependable, consistent and underrated. Brad's career was marked by some serious injuries and making the 100-game mark in 2023 was a great achievement. All the very best to Brad in his future career – whatever that may be.

Congratulations to Anthony Seibold, Tony Mestrov and the whole Club for a great year. We look forward to another enjoyable and hopefully even better 2025.

Finally, I thank my fellow board members for their support and their work on behalf of the members. As a board we strive at all times to represent the views of our members, particularly in our role on the Sea Eagles board. Our voice on that board is your voice. Thank you to all our loyal members for continuing to support the MWRLFC and, of course, the mighty Manly-Warringah Sea Eagles. See you next year and GO MANLY!

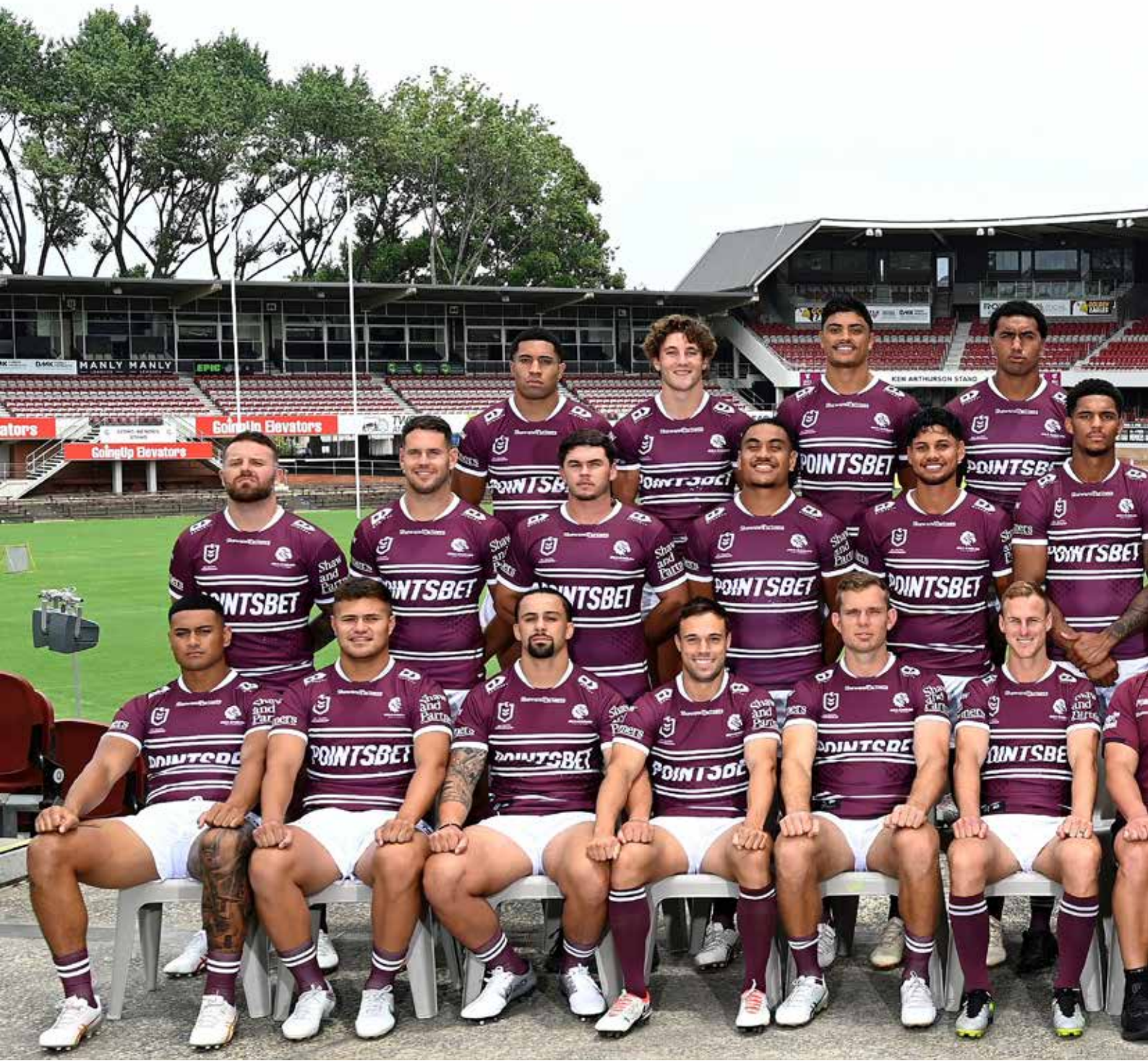

This year we had 2,937 players registered which was a 9.35% increase on the 2023 registered number of players. Continuing a good growth in numbers over recent seasons, following on from a 10.6% increase in the 2023 season.

The number of male players registered of 2,209 showed an increase of 36 players on the player number for 2023 and female players registered totalled 728 was a 42% (215 players) increase on the previous season.

There were 183 teams in 2024 compared to 174 teams in 2023.

The number of volunteers registered of 709 showed a 13% (+83) increase on the registrations for 2023.

This offer was open to all of our Clubs with the majority of the Clubs taking up the Manly Leagues sponsorship offer.

I would like to thank the Leagues Club Board for their contribution and assistance including use of Club facilities when required. The continued financial support of the Manly Leagues Club is paramount to our District Junior Rugby League.

I would also like to thank the Manly Warringah District Football Club who provide general corporate guidance and assistance when appropriate.

In my eighth year as President, I would like to thank my fellow Board Members and everyone who contributed in some way to the running of the game in our District and I look forward to seeing everyone back again in 2025.

# VALE

## GRAHAM "SANDY" HOUSTON - MWRLFC LIFE MEMBER, MEMBER #10

Graham "Sandy" Houston passed away at the grand age of 96 years. Sandy was one of the foundation members of the MWRLFC, recorded as having joined on the 30th of November 1946 and was member number 10. He was a local junior who played in the Manly-Warringah District junior rugby league before moving on to the senior Club where he played between 1949 and 1952 as a hooker for a total of 48 matches in reserves and third grade. Sandy was a true Club Man who devoted much of his life to the MWRLFC and the Manly-Warringah Rugby Leagues Club going right back to its beginning in 1957. Up until relatively recently Sandy never missed a game at Brookvale Oval with fellow Life Member Kerry Sibraa recalling that when the three grades used to play, Sandy would be there before the Third Grade kick off. MWRLFC Board director Ian Thomson described Sandy as a "thorough gentleman". Sandy was made a Life Member of the MWRLFC in 1968.



## REES DUNCAN - PLAYER #93



Rees Duncan was the son of 1930s New South Wales representative forward Rees Duncan senior and grew up in Hunter Valley town of Kurri Kurri, where he began playing seniors as a teenager. Rees was a Kurri Kurri junior who came to Manly as a Centre and Five-Eighth at a contract worth £475. He played 54 first grade games for Manly-Warringah from 1954 to 1956, serving as captain during his first season, then in 1957 returned to Kurri Kurri and coached them to a grand final. In 1952, Duncan had been a surprise selection to the Australia squad for a home series against New Zealand, with his only prior representative experience being with Combined County Seconds. Used as a centre, Duncan featured in two of the three Tests matches. He played for New South Wales in 1952 and 1953. When he was not playing rugby league, Rees was also an electrical engineer who later joined the Police Force. Rees and his wife Dorothy were married for 72 years. He was 92.

## ED WHILEY - MWRLFC LIFE MEMBER, PLAYER #163

Ed "Toy" Whiley was a Manly Christian Brothers junior who played 36 first grade games, 126 reserve grade games and 34 third grade games for the Manly Sea Eagles. He played at half back in the Grand Final winning Jersey Flegg team competing its inaugural season in 1961. He debuted for the first grade team in 1964 and was part of the reserve grade premiership team in 1969. The following year he featured in the 1970 first grade grand final. Ed was awarded Life Membership of the MWRLFC in 1992 and served as its Chairman between 1999-2000. According to the Family of League "Ed was renowned for his willingness to offer his advice and assistance to countless of young rugby league players, upon them beginning to play in the Club's grade teams. He was one of most respected persons in the broad Rugby League Community and throughout the Manly Warringah District, who will always be remembered for his kind manner and warm personality". A true son of Manly.



## PHIL LOWE - PLAYER #226



Phil Lowe was a Great Britain and English International from Hull in Yorkshire. Lowe played 72 first grade games for the Sea Eagles, arriving in Manly in 1974 as part of Ken Arthurson's astute recruitment. He joined fellow Great Britain international Mal Reilly, and hard hitting local junior Terry Randall in what was one of the strongest back rows in the Sydney premiership. He played three seasons for the Sea Eagles and was part of the 1976 Premiership Team which defeated Parramatta 13-10 at the Sydney Cricket Ground, scoring the only try for Manly in the match. The same team also featured two other english players, Steve Norton and Gary Stephens. According to the Guardian he was "a fearless opponent, with a high-stepping running style and exceptional speed for a 16st (101kg), 6ft 2in second-row forward. Lowe made his international debut in New Zealand in 1970 and went on to play 12 times for Great Britain and five times for England". At English club level he played for Hull KR and after finishing his playing career went on to coach York FC.

## TERRY HILL - PLAYER #403

Terry "Tezza" Hill was a powerful running centre with a big "fend" who came to Manly in 1994 recruited by Rugby League Immortal Bob Fulton. Terry had previously played for Souths, Easts and Wests. He played for Manly between 1994 and 1999 and returned in 2005 under then coach Des Hasler for one final season, playing 142 first grade games for the Club in total. He scored 64 tries for 256 points. He featured in three consecutive Grand Finals for Bob Fulton's Sea Eagles in 1995-1997, including the 1996 Premiership victory over St George 20-8. Terry represented Australia nine times between 1994 and 1998, New South Wales 14 times between 1993 and 2000 and City five times. He also played in the victorious Australian team which won the 1995 World Cup against England 16-8 at Wembley's Stadium. Terry was one of the games' great characters renowned as one of the best sledgers in the game (it was said: there was sledging, but Terry was "next level").
